

Graduated sport licenses, passports and eventing 2008

Here is a summary of the sport license and passport requirements for the 2008 eventing season.

Complete information is available on the Equine Canada web site, and is summarized in the Canadian Eventing Committee Winter 2008 Enews newsletter. You purchase sport licenses and passports from Equine Canada. Don't leave it till the last minute, since there likely will be a rush. Leave at least 3 weeks after you send the application to receive the documents. You can find links to both the EC web site and the Enews letter on our web site www.horsetrialspei.ca.

Requirements for horses

Only horses entered in the training division require a passport. You can purchase a temporary passport (good for 1 day) at the HT if that is the route you choose.

Requirements for riders

Riders in the pre-entry, entry and pre-training divisions require a bronze sport license (or higher). Riders in the training division require a silver sport license (or higher). If you have a bronze sport license you can buy a temporary upgrade to silver for the HT if you enter training division. You can buy a temporary bronze sport license (only good for 1 day) at the HT as well.

Requirements for owners

Owners of horses entered in the training division require a silver sport licence (or higher) if the owner is different from the rider. Owners of horses entered in the pre-entry, entry and pre-training divisions **do not** require a bronze sport license (if they are different from the rider).
